Parish Membership

Sick Calls and Ministry to the Sick

Upon request, Holy Communion will be brought to them by one of our Eucharistic Ministers or arrangements can be made with a Priest for a regular monthly visit.

Sacrament of Marriage

Sacrament of Baptism

Parents should arrange with the Parish Office for Baptism. Baptism takes place the 2nd Sunday of the month. Baptism class will be scheduled prior to Baptism.
